Dress Code

Any classes with ballet require: pink ballet shoes, pink tights, and hair off the neck preferably in a bun. Any classes with tap require black tap shoes. For summer and fall performances a black leotard and pink tights are required. If you are attending Variety Class, you will need both tap and ballet shoes. Hip Hop class can wear sweats/shorts/ etc. Street shoes are not allowed on the dance floor. Boys can wear anything they can dance in.

Tuition

- 1.5 Hour Class.....\$240/session or \$60/month**
- 1 Hour Class.....\$220/session or \$55/month**
- 45 Minute Class...\$180/session or \$45/month**
- 30 Minute Class....\$160/session or \$40/month**

Family or Multi-Class Discount:

An additional class or family member is \$25/month per class per session or \$100 for the semester.

All registration forms and payments must be received a week before the start of a session.

Many classes will fill up. To guarantee a spot in class, it is recommended to send in registration and payment early! Register and pay online at www.midmodance.com.

There must be at least 3 students registered and paid to hold class.

Tuition is non-refundable. Tuition is due the first class of the "dance" month. There will be a \$5 late fee after the 15th day of the "dance" month. There will be additional \$5 late fees applied each month.

You must give written notice if you wish to discontinue dance classes and you will be required to pay for classes up until that notice is given. It is assumed that you are registering for the entire semester.

There is a \$50 service charge on all returned checks.

Costumes are non-refundable.
